The research project BENEB (Business Ethics: Normativity and Economic Behavior”) convenes this International Workshop as a venue for discussion of the theory of the social contract as a philosophical foundation for business and economic ethics.

The workshop is intended to bring together scholars from different fields, doing research in both the theoretical and the applied/descriptive dimensions of any of the different contractarian approaches to business and economics ethics, e. g. ISCT, order ethics, Rawlsian, stakeholder fairness, etc.

Empirical/experimental papers, as well as theoretical/historical papers will be welcome. Critical appraisals of the social contract tradition in business, and case studies illustrating aspects of the social contract will be considered also.

Prof. Christoph Lütge (Munich Technical University), Prof. Lorenzo Sacconi (University of Trento), have confirmed their participation.

There is no registration fee. Participants are expected to cover their travel and accommodation expenses.

Authors of accepted papers will be informed by February 28, 2015.

Final program will be announced by the end of March 2015.
